



Lenten Scripture Study

Fr. Connell A. McHugh will again offer a Scripture program during Lent at both churches. Beginning on February 18th, sessions will be held on Thursdays at 9:00 A.M. at Good Shepherd and at 7:00 P.M. at St. John Bosco.

The schedule and topics will be as follows:

Week 1, Feb. 18 – Mary the Mother of Jesus (including how Mary is portrayed in the Gospels, how devotions and doctrines are related to Scripture, etc.)

Week 2, Feb. 25 – Gospel Women (such as Mary Magdalene, Martha and Mary, the Women of Jerusalem)

Week 3, Mar. 4 – Ministry Christology and Post New Testament Christology (How the Gospel writers differ in their presentations of Jesus and how Christology developed after the written Gospels.)

Week 4, Mar. 11 – The Knowledge of Jesus (The difficulties involved in balancing Jesus' humanity and divinity especially in regard to his knowledge. What did Jesus know of everyday affairs, Scripture, the future, his mission, his eventual death, etc.?)

Week 5, Mar. 18 – Early Christological Hymns (Hymns in the New Testament, the early church, those sung by Christians, the fathers of the church. How the early Councils viewed the Christological hymns, how they reflected Jesus' divinity and humanity.)

You may attend any or all of the sessions. Registration is requested so that we will have sufficient materials for all participants. All sessions will be held on Thursdays, and you may attend at either 9 A.M. at Good Shepherd or at 7 P.M. at St. John Bosco. The sessions are open to all regional parishes.
